GNSO Improvements Implementation Phases

Phase 1: GNSO Council restructuring implementation plan submitted in advance of the Dec 2008 Board Meeting

Phase 2: Existing Constituencies submit confirmation documents to the Board for review in advance of the Feb 2009 Board Meeting

Phase 3: Stakeholder Groups submit formal plans for Board approval for consideration at the Mar 2009 Mexico City ICANN Board meeting





Phase 4: Stakeholder Groups with plans approved by the Board select Council representatives, and the newly structured GNSO Council is seated by the Jun 2009 Asia-Pacific ICANN Meeting
